


Meeting with Twin Aire Neighborhood Coalition

Community Justice Campus Surrounding Infrastructure Improvements Indianapolis, Marion County, Indiana November 19, 2020







AMERICAN STRUCTUREPOINT INC.

Project Investment – New Addition

- Nearly \$10 million investment in infrastructure surrounding the new Community Justice Campus
- 2'-0" grass/low-maintenance landscape strip added between curb and sidewalk for pedestrian safety and assist the visually impaired



Anticipated Project Schedule

- Bridge over Pleasant Run under construction
 - Construction 2020 and early 2021
- NEW Advanced Clearing Contract
 - Clear properties and remove buildings on parcels in direct conflict with necessary CJC roadway improvements to expedite road construction in anticipation of CJC opening January 2022
 - Can start clearing as early as December 2020 and complete by May 2021

Anticipated Project Schedule

- Clearing contract bid letting November 19, 2020
 - Start clearing late December 2020 at earliest
- Road contract land acquisition complete February 1, 2021
- Road final contract documents to DPW (100%) February 15, 2021
- Road advertise February 20, 2021
- Road bid letting March 11, 2021
- Substantial completion for clearing contract April 1, 2021
- Final clearing contract complete May 15, 2021
- Road construction April/May 2021 through Summer 2022
 - Goal: CJC main entrance, significant portion of roundabout, RPR and SE intersection substantially done by mid October 2021 for CJC move-in
 - Southeastern Avenue open to traffic at all times
- Community Justice Campus open Target January 2022
- All road construction complete Summer 2022


Early Action Funds: Proposed Projects

- Increased amenities around Indy Go Bus Stops, including seating, trash containers, etc.
- Crime Prevention through Environmental Design (CPTED) training for TANC community, along with implementation for CPTED activities and projects.
- Improved access in Clayton/La Salle Parks by providing additional seating/benches.
- Displays featuring the history of each neighborhood in area parks, including pocket parks, using material collected from seniors in the area
- Creation of a neighborhood task force to address crime.
- Creation of a farmer's market in Twin Aire (new)
- Story Telling Project and Art Display to highlight diverse heritage and history of the area such as "I am From" poems (new)

Livability Feedback and Suggestions

- Concerns about traffic/accidents/poor driving
- Infrastructure improvements
- More lights/cameras needed for crime prevention
- Neighborhood clean-ups/too much trash around the area
- Programs/projects to house/relocate individuals experiencing homelessness
- Connector for Pleasant Run Trail
- Our Stories: a public engagement Place-making tile piece reflecting stories of residents displayed in Clayton LaSalle Park, involving collecting stories of neighbors, and community clay engagements.





Opportunity Feedback and Suggestions

- Fix up the Twin Aire Shopping Center, including support for businesses, cleaning up the trash/area, and support for other façade improvements
- Coworking shared space
- Add a grocery store
- Add a farmer's market, accessible in both warm and cold months
- Provide opportunities for teens, possibly through creating a Twin Aire YMCA location
- Use young artists to create murals, public art, art made of cut down trees





Vitality New Feedback and Suggestions

- Work with local investors to buy small multifamily properties as opposed to only assisting large developers
- Offer low interest loans for people to fix up their property
- Create a land bank separate from renew Indy that is specific to Twin Aire goals
- More comfort for senior properties and better rent controls in senior housing, i.e. no yearly increases in rent





Education Feedback and Suggestions

- Merge housing and education/trade/skilled training by creating a program (or partnering with an existing program) where people receive construction training/apprenticeship on site by renovating/building housing in the area.
 - Housing improvements could be used to help with affordable housing in the area.
- Add a theatre in Twin Aire
- Community art engagements, including bilingual programming, in Clayton LaSalle Park to help create community, inclusion, and feelings of ownership in the neighborhood
- Sponsor/subsidize Financial Peace University and/or ESOL classes at a community center
- Training/education for job/career development
