- Reuben Engagement Center
  - Will provide detox and connection to continuum of care

#### Public Infrastructure Update

- DPW and Structurepoint presented to TANC in February 2020
- \$9.6M Funding for Improving:
  - Traffic Signals
  - Roads
  - Connectivity
  - Bike Lanes and Trails
- Two Phases of Project
  - Tier 1 (EB Pleasant Run Pkwy.)
  - Tier 2 (WB Pleasant Run Pkwy.)




#### Public Infrastructure Update

- •These Infrastructure Improvements will be made in the surrounding areas of the neighborhood (not inside the CJC Campus)
- Main purpose to facilitate the entrance/exit of the CJC Campus



#### Public Infrastructure Update

- A Multi-Use Path will be widened and connect Pleasant Run Trail with the CJC Campus and English Ave.
- It will provide additional ADA Compliant sidewalks to the neighborhood













## Concentric and Radiating: Twin Aire Medallions


